

Did you know that some subcontractors are eligible to be excluded from the Workers' Compensation Statute coverage?

If you qualify, you need to get a Notice of Exclusion letter from the State of Michigan.

How do you know if you or a subcontractor qualify?

You must work alone.

AND

✓ Do not hire employees, laborers, independent contractors or subcontractors.

To find out if you qualify for this exclusion and obtain the WC-337 Form, contact the Michigan Compliance Division at 517 322 1195. Visit the **State of Michigan website:** michigan.gov

- 1. The form must be completed, then notarized and returned to the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (indicated on the form)
- 2. The Michigan Department of Licensing will date, stamp and record in their records. They will return the stamped form to you.
- **3.** The form may be copied and given to a business owner/general contractor. The exclusion becomes effective on the date stamped.
